Comment : All seven schools in Southwest Region School District are Title I Schoolwide schools. The district coordinates with Impact Aid, Title I, Title II, and the general budget to support the objectives of the Title VII program. This includes salaries for the project director, project coordinator, and instructional staff, instructional supplies, curriculum development, and professional development. Indian children in the grade span 6-8 were added to the target population. The target population for the Indian Education activities is all Indian Students in grades K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and students in grades 9-12 that enrolled in Yup'ik studies courses. The target population participated in the activity on a daily basis. The target population in the first cultural enrichment activity is all Indian Students in grades K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and students in grades 9-12 that enrolled in Yup'ik studies courses; this activity was fully implemented and 90% of students completed the language survey. The target population in the second cultural enrichment activity is all Indian Students in grades K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and students in grades 9-12 that enrolled in Yup'ik studies courses. The target population participated in the TPRS instruction and Yup'ik Studies courses, however the non-standardized assessments have not been completely implemented. Non-standardized assessments are still be developed and the professional development to implement assessments with fidelity needs to continue.
