THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Southwest Region School District Parent Advisory Committee recommends the following:

The District completes a review of the culturally related instruction programs to ensure that all students had opportunities to learn and participate in local cultural activities. Examples included Yup'ik dancing, involving elders, and expanding Eweek offerings.
